- Assist with Section 8
 Re-certification
 Packets
- Provide ongoing Supportive Services





Supportive Services

- Link residents with community resources
- >Link residents with agency services
- Provide recovery and support groups
- ➤ Assist with applications & re-certifications
- Conduct monitoring and follow-up activities

Unique Situations

- Transgender Clients
- > Service Animals
- Relapse/Substance Abuse Matters
- Clients with no social support; no emergency contact



- ➤ Ensure and respect the client's right to self-determination
- > Afford great dignity and respect
- ➤ Believe strongly in the success of the clients you serve
- > Reinforce the client's strengths
- Provide a full spectrum of supportive services

- ➤ Provide amenities that contribute to client rehabilitation
- Ensure accessibility of Case Managers
- ➤ Work in conjunction with community agencies
- > Collaborate with governmental entities
- > Train staff
